Invitation for Proposal of the Traffic Study for Multan Northern Bypass

IPDF in collaboration with National Highway Authority (NHA) hereby invites a Request for Proposal (RFP) from interested private parties to participate in the above mentioned Study.

Infrastructure Project Development Facility (IPDF) is a Company established under the aegis of Ministry of Finance, Government of Pakistan, to facilitate the development of infrastructure projects under Public Private Partnership modality.

National Highway Authority (NHA) intends to eradicate congestion and pressure of extraneous traffic from Multan city road network. It has therefore initiated the project of Multan Northern Bypass Road - Linking N-5 and Multan Mianwali Road (MMR) via Muhammad Wala Bridge to facilitate increasing traffic volume and bypassing city traffic. The consultant will be required to:

- Conduct Traffic Study including counts on crossing Roads, turning volumetric counts on key junctions, journey time survey, delay studies on key links, Origin/Destination Survey, Manual Classified Counts (MCC), Willing to pay survey, traffic assessment and traffic modelling for next 30 years.
