Invitation for Submission of Proposals for Advisory Services for the Development of Center of Liver Diseases and Transplant (CLOT) at PIMS Under Public Private Partnership Modality

Pakistan Institute of Medical Sciences / Ministry of Health aims to develop a dedicated facility for Liver Disease and Transplant on Pakistan Institute of Medical Sciences (PIMS) premises.

The project primarily aims at establishing a viable and sustainable liver transplant program that meets international standards. The center is proposed to cover all areas of management of liver diseases.

The CLOT facility is proposed to be constructed on land provided by PIMS on its current facility located on main Ibn-e-Sina road, Islamabad. It is envisaged that the facility will cater to 40 beds which will be expanded over time and will have state-of-the-art medical equipment and specialized staff of doctors, nurses and ancillary staff. The Centre will provide surgical procedures for liver, gallbladder and pancreatic medical cases and will also provide liver related diagnostic and therapeutic endoscopy facilities. The facility will also house diagnostic and interventional radiology and comprehensive laboratory testing facilities.

IPDF is seeking transaction advisory services from qualified advisory firms ideally led by a reputable financial institution / investment bank and comprising of requisite technical, legal and other consultants to assist in the implementation of the Project. The Transaction Advisory team (consisting of financial, legal and technical expertise) will in structuring the best PPP option to implement the project. The best PPP option will be one that provides 'value for money' to PIMS / MoH, is affordable to the users and can be implemented with ease.
